



TEENAGE PREGNANCY INCREASES WHEN GIRLS LACK INFORMATION ABOUT SEXUAL AND REPRODUCTIVE HEALTH AND RIGHTS.



ANNUAL PERCENTAGE OF BABIES BORN TO MOTHERS AGED 10-19 YEARS OLD

IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF LA HUERTA,
WHERE THE CAREYES FOUNDATION OPERATES



DURING 2020, 21.88% OF BABIES BORN IN LA HUERTA WERE BORN TO MOTHERS BETWEEN THE AGES OF 10 & 19, AN INCREASE OF 5.39% FROM THE PREVIOUS YEAR.



Each person has their own subjective experience of living with others in society, which is why it is important to talk about themes of gender and mental health, as it is an important element of healthy sexuality in relation to the people who surround us.



Some questions were related to moral implications of masturbation and common myths

"If I masturbate a lot, can I lose my memory?"

"Is it bad to masturbate?"

Religions still impact sexual identity and activity, which is often seen as taboo or prohibited. Because of these beliefs, adolescents may feel ashamed or afraid to go to their parents or to a health center to start using a family planning method. "It is a barrier that should be removed to improve the options and tools that they should have, and that are part of sexual rights" (García, 2021).
